Important Dates To Put On Your Calendar

As many of you are already aware, our facilities planning team has made great progress this summer. They will be sharing a building proposal along with a recommendation that we hire a particular construction company with the Board of Deacons on Sunday, July 29th. We're all hopeful that following that meeting, the deacons will be prepared on Sunday, August 5th to recommend to the church that we adopt these plans and hire a contractor to begin construction, most likely early next year.

Here's a schedule for how we tentatively plan to move forward and for how I hope you'll be engaged in this process over the next few weeks:

Wednesday, August 1— Ministry Group/Stakeholder meetings to preview particular ministry areas (Times TBA)

Sunday, August 5— Presentation of a motion from the deacons to move forward with the building plan at the conclusion of both worship services with materials available for review. No action will be taken on the motion on the 5th.

Wednesday, August 8— Church-wide discussion of the proposal with key leaders present (architects, contractors, church leaders) to guide the conversation following dinner at 5:30 PM in the Fellowship Hall.

Sunday, August 12— A vote to approve the motion presented by the deacons on August 5th at the conclusion of both services.

There are a lot of moving pieces to this process, with some details still to be determined. Rest assured, though, that your congregational leaders are working very hard to make sure you're informed and engaged as they finalize a proposal that I hope you'll be very excited about. Once the congregation has the chance to officially approve the project, we plan to move forward with a formal fundraising campaign in September.

Your participation, input and feedback have been invaluable in this process so far. Over the next several weeks, I hope you'll continue to be engaged in every way you can. One thing you can do right now is to continue to keep this process in your prayers.
