### Clarifying Donations – Please Help!

Although the capital campaign will not officially kick off until next month, we have seen a number of donations already coming into the church office. Please help us properly process these as well as other special gifts by doing the following:

- Clearly designate if your gift is intended for the **2018 Capital Campaign** or other restricted account. As a reminder, we have an existing **Building Fund** which was created in 2003 with the purpose of providing a source of funds for major repairs and renovations. We continue to gladly accept donations to this fund but it is separate from the new capital campaign. When you designate your gift for the “Building Fund,” it goes into this 2003 renovation account. Donations for the new capital campaign should be designated “Capital Campaign.”
- Stock Donors** – please be sure Debbie ([dporrello@centralbaptistnewnan.org](mailto:dporrello@centralbaptistnewnan.org)) is aware of any pending stock gifts in advance. Some stocks come into the church’s brokerage account with no identifying information as to donor or intended purpose. It is much simpler for all parties if we can properly account for these gifts at the time received rather than correcting after the fact. The only way to be sure you receive contribution credit and your gift is used for its intended purpose is to notify Debbie. Please do not depend on your broker to provide this information to the church.
