CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

We will begin our worship class for 1st-2nd graders on September 9th. This class will take place upstairs in the children's department. (We will not have the worship class on 10/7 or 11/18 do to holiday weekends. All children PK4-2nd grade will be combined for children's church those weeks in the Little Lambs room.) Becca Springfield and I will take this opportunity to talk to these children about what the different parts of the worship service mean, they will learn the Christian year calendar, and gain the confidence they need to feel a part of worship (not just a bystander while their parents worship).

Ways, you as a parent, can help your child get the most out of worship and worship class...

1. Make sure your child is getting the worship folder specially designed for children (PreK-5). They can be found next to the adult worship folders and there is one inside the worship bags.
2. Help your child follow along while they are in worship with you. You may suggest they find hymns/scriptures before worship starts so they can follow along as we sing/read.
3. Please encourage your child to leave personal belongings (purses, candy, toys, etc..) with you instead of allowing them to bring them when they come for the children sermon/class. These types of things can become very distracting for your child and other children trying to pay attention.
4. Encourage your child to go to the restroom before worship. We understand emergencies arise, but minimal movement helps children (and adults) stay on task.
5. Starting on December 30th, 1-2 graders will remain in worship the rest of the year to practice what they learned in class. PK4-K will continue to go to children's church after the children's sermon. Please note that I would encourage any and ALL children to join me for the children's sermon even if they are not leaving for children's church. This will allow them an opportunity to get up and move around.
6. As the worship class only lasts for the first part of the year make sure your child joins us as much as possible so they do not miss out on what is being taught. Understanding the elements of worship will be the first step in helping them feel like they belong.
