Pastor's Pen

Order and Simplicity

Over the last several years I've developed a devotional habit of writing in a journal each morning. It's the first thing I do each day when I sit down in my office chair at the church. As part of that habit I write two key-words at the top of each day's page—the same two words for an entire year. My words this year are "Order" and "Simplicity."

Those words become a daily reminder of what I'm aiming for as I seek to more fully become who God created me to be. And when I come to days or moments during the year when I need to re-focus, re-prioritize, re-orient, or reassess, these are the words I use to do that. Last year the words were different. I'll choose new words for 2024. But "Order" and "Simplicity" have served me well so far in 2023.

Order, for me, is a reminder that everything in life ought to have a proper purpose and a proper place—physical places for physical objects—and spiritual or emotional places for practices and relationships. Sometimes things sneak out of their places like toys that escape the playroom in our home, and they start to creep in and overwhelm. Order is a reminder that my life seems much more manageable when everything is in its proper place, starting with my faith being right at the center of who I'm aiming to be.

Simplicity is a reminder that only a few things are truly important in life. We'd be better off eliminating much of what we worry about and spend our time on. The simple life really is the good life. Family, health, meaningful work, strong relationships, emotional well-being, and time to do the things you love with the people you love. Most everything else can be eliminated.

The process of moving out of summer and into the busier routines of fall can be overwhelming for some people. If that's true for you right now, maybe a focus on "Order" and "Simplicity" will be as helpful for you as it is for me.
