## PREVIEW: Wednesday Night Bible Study

We get back to Wednesday night supper on August 16. We'll host a BIG Fall Ministry Preview Night on Wednesday, August 23. And then we get into our regular fall ministry activities on Wednesday, August 30.

Wednesday Night Adult Bible Study this fall will focus on the "other" books of the New Testament—not the gospels and not the letters of Paul. We'll focus on Peter, James, and John instead, spending most of our time looking at the books of 1 John, 1 Peter and James as we go verse-by-verse through selected passages to discover together how these authors shape our faith today and how they helped to form the foundations of the church. We'll also ask the questions, "Who on earth is the author of Hebrews?" and "What about Revelation?"

In addition we'll have three REST prayer and communion services, a Thanksgiving opportunity for church-wide fellowship, and a special Christmas Communion service on Wednesday nights between now and Christmas. If Wednesday nights are already part of your school-year routine, we'll look forward to welcoming you back. If they're not, consider this a personal invitation to give it a try. Wednesday nights are great opportunities to get to know your fellow church members as we study the Bible and encourage one another in the faith together.
