Seizing the Moment of New Discovery

We've spent all summer working through Paul's Letter to the Romans in worship. An energy of new discovery flows throughout the letter, as does an urgency to seize the moment and claim our full identity in Christ now that the full work of salvation has been accomplished through Christ's death and resurrection.

Here are a few ways you might consider seizing the moment today, gleaned from Paul's Letter to the Romans:

- 1. Embrace the truth that the rules-based system of living is being laid aside in favor of a life lived according to the Spirit. We aim for moral living in response to God's free gift of grace (already given) rather than as a way to achieve or earn God's grace sometime in the future. There's great freedom in that realization.
- 2. Embrace the belief that the world is centered around an unfailing goodness and grace most clearly revealed in the person of Jesus Christ. God's plan of salvation and restoration has been in place from the beginning and is being worked out in love right now. With this in mind, you'll avoid the pervasive cynicism of our world and enjoy an appropriately hopeful Christian outlook for the future instead.
- 3. Redouble your efforts to love your neighbor, and do it now. The timing is right to love right now. All the pieces are in place. God's truth has been revealed. And the way we respond to the full revelation of God in Jesus Christ is by loving one another. What does that look like? Generosity, forgiveness, overlooking faults, actively seeking reconciliation, and living with a joy that leads others to feel welcome in your presence.

Next Sunday in worship we'll leave Romans for a passage from Exodus instead—but it's about taking advantage of the right timing, too.
