

Pastor's Pen

De-Centering Ourselves

We often imagine ourselves at the center of things. On Sunday in worship we noticed how that was true in our explorations of the universe. For centuries we thought that the earth was at the center of the solar system. And we noticed how that was true in how we think about the world map. The maps we're most familiar with place our home in North America in a central location. And we noticed how that was true in our pursuit of holiness. Surely our own self-improvement ought to be the chief aim of that endeavor.

But we aren't at the center of the solar system, and plenty of perfectly good maps push the United States way off to the side, and our own self-improvement isn't at the center of what it means to be holy.

Scripture reminds us that holiness is a Godcentered, "other"-directed enterprise. Decentering ourselves can be a bit disorienting, but it's worth it. Holiness is a reflection of God's character in our lives, and we best reflect God's character when love of neighbor is our primary aim. In this way, self-improvement is a by-product of that process rather than its primary goal.

That means we don't have to be the heroes of our own stories. We can let the God revealed in Jesus Christ have the role. And the story God will write for us when we approach holiness that way is far better than any story we would write for ourselves.
