Encourager Church Missions Partnership

On Sunday, our church entered into a formal Encourager Church partnership with Cooperative Baptist Fellowship (CBF) missionaries Kirk and Susie



Person. As an act of worship we signed a covenant with them in which we each committed to provide material and spiritual support for the other. The Cooperative Baptist Fellowship is a party to our covenant as well, committing to provide logistical and administrative support to our partnership and to promote this partnership as a model among other CBF churches and organizations.

Kirk and Suzie have been serving in Southeast Asia for nearly three decades. They've worked primarily among indigenous tribal people to develop written alphabets with them so that the truths of our faith and the good news of Jesus Christ can be communicated and shared in their native tribal languages for the very first time.

Their long-term presence among these people groups is a model for effective ministry and missions engagement, and it's a real privilege for us to be able to partner with them in this new way. Our new financial commitments to Kirk and Suzie are in addition to our longstanding support of the overall missions efforts of the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship through our weekly budget offerings and our annual gifts to the CBF Offering for Global Missions.

As we begin this new partnership, remember to pray this week for Kirk, Suzie, and the people they serve in Southeast Asia.
