Christmas Is Here

All that we've been waiting and preparing for is quickly approaching. I hope you've enjoyed the Advent season as much as I have because we only have a few days of Advent left now. Most of us have been celebrating Christmas at church for our whole lives, so we think we know what the season means, we're sure we know what all the merry-making is for. But it never hurts to be reminded.

The God who created the entire universe, the source of all light and energy, the source of all matter and life, the creative force and the inspiring mind behind all that ever has been and all that ever will be, chose to be present on earth in the form of a human being. 
