Pastor's Pen

The Different Names for God

We'll be looking at the different names for God in the Old Testament this semester in Wednesday Night Bible Study. Theologian Walter Brueggemann reminds us that if we want to get our hands around any particular scripture text, one of the best places to start is by looking at the names/words used to describe God in the text.

Another way is to find the verbs. What is God doing in the text? For example, Genesis 1:1 begins, "In the beginning, God CREATED..." God's first identity in scripture is as creator. By one count there are as many as 967 names and titles for God in the Bible. We won't look at all of them! We'll just explore the most prominent ones in the Old Testament as we explore the scripture passages in which those names and titles appear.

As we explore the names together, I hope we'll discover just how multi-faceted the identity of God is as we remember that the totality of God's identity and presence is far beyond what we can comprehend. I hope it can also be an opportunity for us to see the Bible as a record of our evolving understanding of who God is as divine disclosure and human knowledge increased across the centuries and millennia. We might even discover that we still have more to learn—and that God continues to be revealed through our growing understanding even now.

I hope you'll join us on Wednesdays this semester. We meet this Wednesday at 6:00 pm in the sanctuary.
