The 48-Hour Challenge

As we conclude the 48-Hour Challenge, I want to thank each of you for your engagement and participation in this year-long attendance emphasis. When you start something like this, you both don't know if folks will buy in to it and you don't know if it's the kind of thing that can be sustained for an entire year. Thank you for approaching the Challenge in the lighthearted but meaningful way it was intended, and for sticking with it.

Here's what I've learned from the Challenge:

- 1. Your presence at Central matters, and it matters just as much to those around you as it does to yourself. Your neighbor's experience at Central is elevated when you are present next to them. EVERY one of you is better than an empty chair!
- 2. The shared experience of worship is real. Our Challenge this year has engrained this truth even more deeply in me. Sometimes things happen in worship, little transforming moments, that connect us. If you're not here to experience the moment, you don't just miss out on the moment, you miss out on the connection, too.
- 3. **God is transforming us together**. As we continue to make and keep commitments to God and one another (including our commitments to be present for worship and Bible study), God is keeping God's commitments to change us, too. Individually and collectively, we are being transformed. I'm a better Christian today than I was last Labor Day, and I know why, too. I'm a better, more faithful follower of Christ today because of you. God is keeping God's commitments to me through you.

I pray the same is true for each of you.
