Pastor's Pen

The Surprise of Christmas

Our worship theme for Advent is "Surprise." Christmas came as a surprise to all who encountered it that first year in Bethlehem, and Christmas still surprises us today. While the actual events (baby in a manger, angels and shepherds, etc.) have grown familiar to us over the years, the meaning behind the events continues to have the power to shake us up a little.

Last Sunday we talked about the surprise of God's nearness. At Christmas, God comes close to us in ways we aren't expecting. And, as time sneaks up on us, God's arrival both at Christmas and at the second coming is nearer to us than we might ordinarily imagine. For the next three weeks of Advent, we'll talk about the surprise of God's welcome, the surprise of God's subversiveness, and the surprise of God's salvation.

God's welcome at Christmas included more people than the first believers were expecting, and God's welcome includes more people than we are likely to include if we're not careful. The gospels go to great lengths to demonstrate God's universal intent in the birth of Christ. The circle of God's welcome at the manger starts big and just keeps getting bigger as God's story in Jesus Christ unfolds. We'll talk about that this Sunday.

Two Sundays from now we'll look at the Magnificat, Mary's song of praise and acceptance upon learning that she would be the mother of the Son of God. There's a big surprise for us in Mary's understanding of what will be accomplished through her; it's shockingly subversive! Mary sees that the birth of Christ will turn everything upside down and upend social hierarchies and power structures. It's a good message, but it's a surprising message, and not always an easy one to digest.

On the last Sunday before Christmas, we'll talk about the surprise of God's salvation. When God speaks to Joseph through an angel to tell him about the birth of Jesus, the message of the angel to Joseph is one of the most positive, encouraging, affirming, uplifting messages anyone could have ever received. We'll remember that God speaks to us the same way this Christmas. The fullness of the meaning of God's salvation FOR US continues to surprise.

Christmas really is the most wonderful time of the year at Central. We've got great worship services planned throughout the month of December. Join us each week and invite a friend.


Please keep our Christmas Schedule handy so you don't miss out on any opportunity to share the good news of Christ's incarnation.
